Information and Proposed Schedule

Friday afternoon Shake-down run. 1:30pm depart Rally HQ for 75km ride to Canowindra and return. Optional visit to the *Age of Fishes Museum* for those who are interested in fossils of bizarre fish that lived in the rivers of the Central West in an age before the dinosaurs.

Evening meal: No formal arrangements in place though many rally-goers will dine at the Imperial Hotel, a short walk from rally HQ.

Saturday. 9:15am bike display at Bryant Park (car park near bridge, opposite Tourist Info Centre). 10am depart for ride north via quiet country roads through the Windowrie district and on to historic 1827 convict-built Croote Cottage (once visited by bushranger Ben Hall) near Gooloogong. Then, back to the Gooloogong Hotel for BBQ lunch, approx. \$18 pp, pay on the day. Fuel available at Gooloogong. Distance approx. 100km.

Saturday night dinner and entertainment at Cowra Bowling & Recreation Club, 27 Vaux St. (500m from rally HQ). Car park off Brougham St. Pre-dinner drinks from 5:30pm, dinner at 6:30pm, approx. \$32 pay at the venue (set menu, alternating chicken / lamb + dessert). Please

Sunday. 10am depart rally HQ for Wyangala Dam via Woodstock and Darby's Falls. Lunch at Wyangala Country Club approx..\$15-20 pp, pay on the day. Return to Cowra (33km) via Scrubby Rush Rd. **No fuel available at Wyangala** (support vehicle will carry petrol). Total distance approx. 105km.

Evening meal. No formal arrangements.

Monday. 9am depart rally HQ for heritage listed landra Castle via Koorawattha and Greenethorpe. landra site entry \$15. Please have correct cash ready. **Tea & coffee available \$5.** **Generous morning tea provided by Greenethorpe Public School P&C for a nominal fee.** **No fuel at Greenethorpe** (backup vehicle will carry fuel). Total 105 km.

Breakdown vehicle and some corner marshals will be provided.
